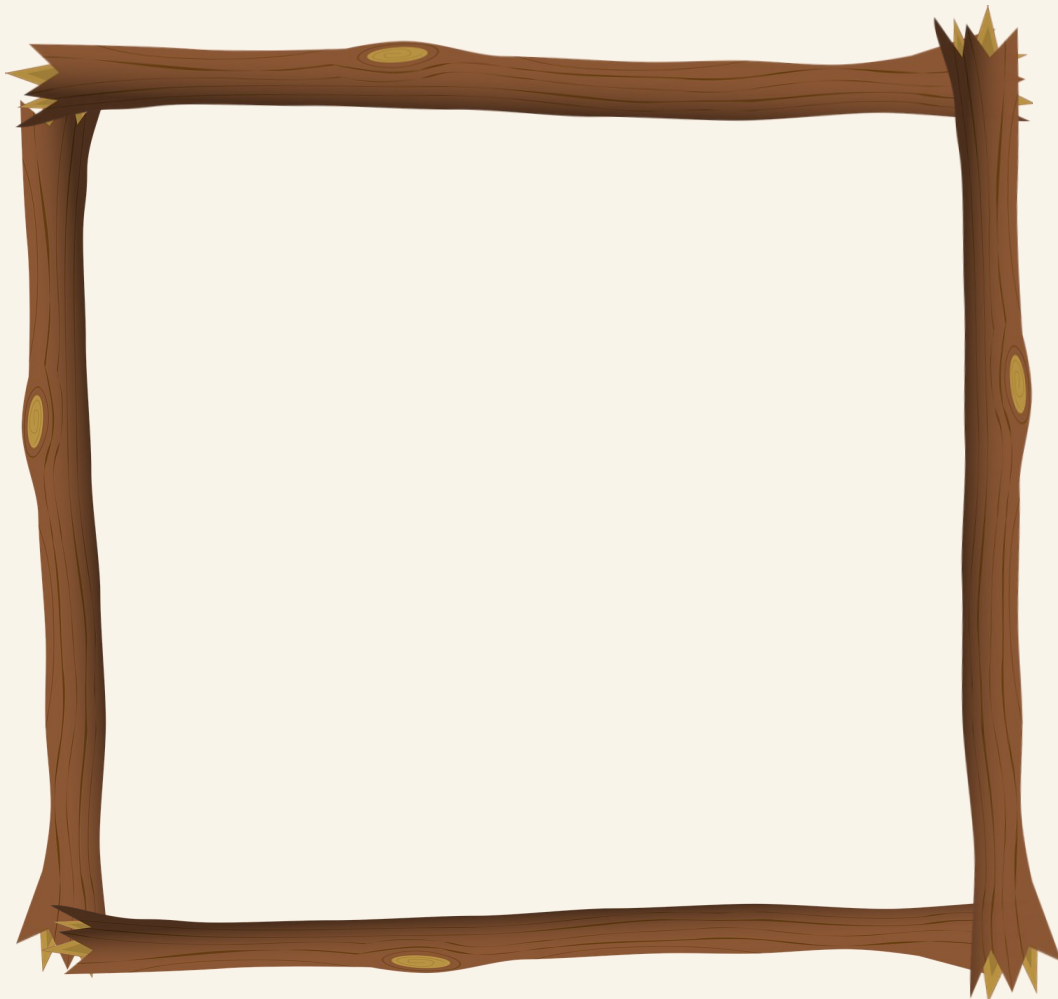


Create a memento of your favourite tree!

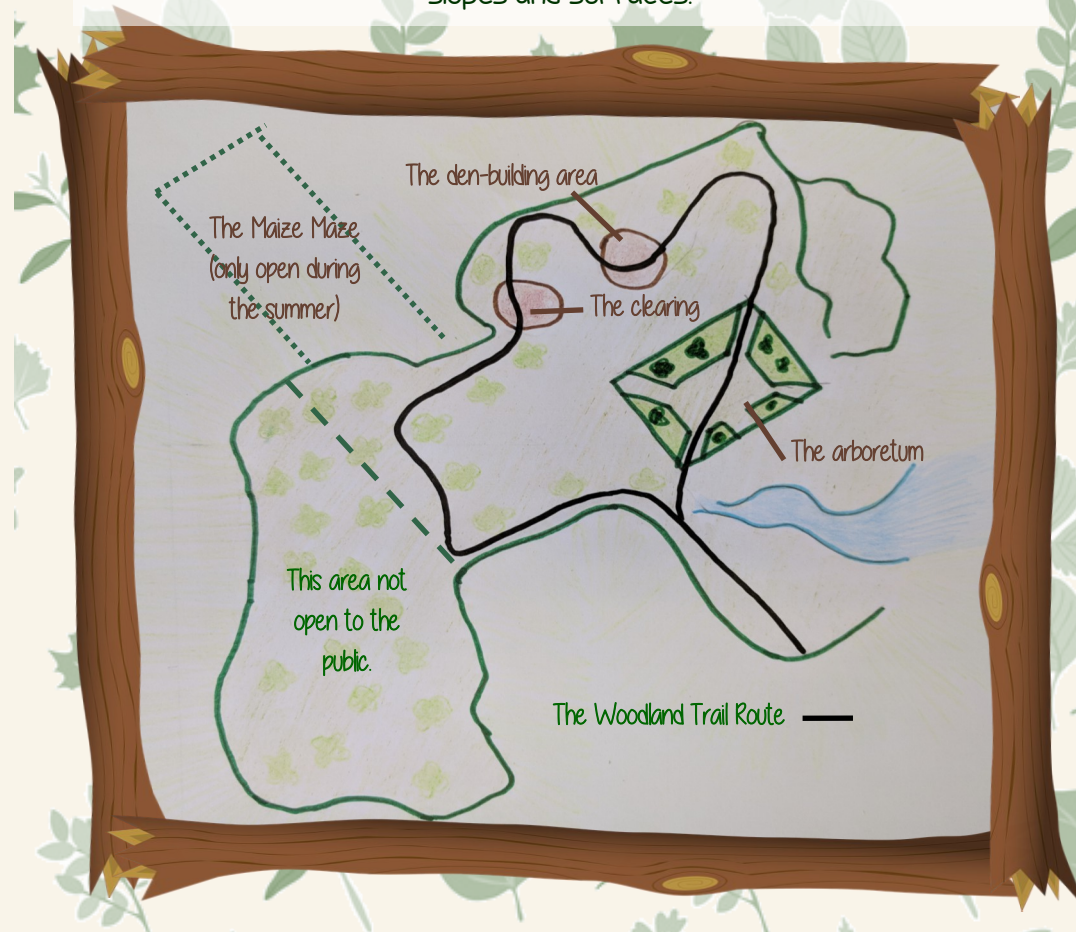

Woodland Trail Nature Hunt

















The Woodland Trail is 192m from the visitor entrance and the whole Trail is a loop of just under 1km, consisting of 3 different walks of approximately 0.5km each. The paths may be muddy but can be navigated with an all-terrain style pushchair. Wheelchairs may struggle due to the slopes and surfaces.
